## Rules & Regulations for the course of B.Sc. Medical Technology(MLT/OTAT/RMIT)

**Introduction:-** Aim is to train the students in all the routine, special and sophisticated diagnostic procedures in the field of Medical Technology.

Short Title Commencement: The regulation shall be called the Regulation for B. Sc. Medical Technology Course of the Dharmsinh Desai University.

The regulation and syllabus framed is subjected to modification/amendment from time to time by board of studies of Dharmsinh Desai University.

- **1. Eligibility for Admission:** a) Candidates who have passed 10+2 examination conducted by any recognized School Certification Board or Equivalent Examination; with principal subjects Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Maths and English (A or B or AB group student).
- b) Selection of the candidates will be based on merit i.e., qualifying mark obtained in examination of the year of admission.
- c) Age Limit: The candidate should have completed the age of 17 years at the time of admission or would be completed the said age on or before 31st Dec of the year of admission to the first year B.Sc. MT.
- **2) Duration:** The duration of the Course is 3 years + One year internship is compulsory for OTAT and RMIT course.
- 3) Medium of Instruction and language of Examination: English
- **4) Academic Programme:** During an academic year, a candidate shall be en-rolled only for one programme of studies and shall not appear in any other examination of this or other university.
- 5) Commencement of the Course: 15th June of each academic year.
- **6) Commencement of Examination:** Examination will be fixed by university after due consultation with the concerned Head of the Institution/department.
- 7) Working Days: Each academic year shall consist of not less than 180 working days.
- **8) Registration:** A candidate admitted to the course shall register with the Dharmsinh University by remitting the prescribed fees along with the application form.
